Xavier Girls Basketball Summer Camps

Xavier Girls Basketball is excited to offer two different basketball camps this summer. The first camp will be for girls entering 3rd & 4th Grade. This camp will run from June 25th - 28th. We will work on basic basketball skill and introduce our skill progression system.

Our second camp of the summer will be for girls entering 5th - 8th grade. This camp will run from July 31st - Aug. 16th. We are calling this summer basketball school as we will run this for 3 weeks on Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday nights from 6-7:30pm. We will take a more advanced approach to our skill progression system, work on advanced footwork and pivoting, man-to-man defensive understanding, how to never feel pressure while having the ball in your hands and finish with contact. We will also work on proper shooting technique and video each player and break down their shot with them.
