# ACT Test Prep

ACT Test Prep will be offering a class at Xavier to prepare students for the October 17th test at school. The prep class is scheduled for October 9-12th from 4pm-7:15pm. A practice exam, teacher led-instructional sessions, and materials will be provided to participating students. Please note, signing up for the prep class does NOT automatically register your student to take the exam on Oct 17th - be sure to also connect with the main office by October 3rd to ensure you've secured a test!

#### **ACT Fee Waivers Available**

Families are reminded that ACT.org does allow students who qualify to receive up to 2 waivers for taking the ACT test. If you believe your family might qualify, please connect with your child's counselor or have your student stop in the Counseling Suite to find out more details.

# **AP Testing Sign Up**

Students interested in taking an AP test must register AND make a payment no later than Friday, November 11. This information can be found on the <u>Xavier Counseling Website</u>. Each AP test costs \$98. Students can either pay with cash/check or have the fee applied to their Blackbaud Tuition account. Late registration will cost an additional \$55. If a student decides not to take the test, a refund will be made (cost minus the ordering cost of \$40).

Students who received accommodations for the PLAN, ACT or SAT must see Mr. Neiswender immediately to discuss possible accommodations for AP testing. The deadline to apply for accommodations is January 2023. If you have any questions regarding AP testing, please see your AP teacher or talk with Mrs. Schuh.

## Testing Day Tuesday, Oct 17, 2023

Freshmen and sophomores will take the PreACT -- a practice ACT designed for 9th and 10th graders. This test will be given at no cost to all freshmen and sophomores. No prep is needed. Details will be provided in the coming weeks.

Juniors will have the opportunity to take the ACT (no writing) at Xavier High School. Xavier is offering this optional ACT so that our juniors have one ACT that is guaranteed to occur on-site. Juniors may certainly wait until later in the year to take the ACT. Scores from this October 17 test can be used for college applications. A test prep class will be offered especially for this test date.

Seniors may also take the October 17 ACT at Xavier, if they wish. If they do not take the ACT, they should work on other college-related activities, such as their applications and essays, that morning and can stay home to do so.

Classes will meet in the afternoon as usual.

# Athletic Code Video & Paperwork Info

There is a new process for paperwork this year, as we've gone digital. The first part of the process is the Xavier Athletic Code Video. Luke Herriges, our athletic director, covers many of the high points of the athletic code. You must watch this video before proceeding on to the electronic forms.

#### **IMPORTANT NOTES BEFORE BEGINNING:**

- 1. The video should be watched on a computer. There are questions that must be answered alongside the video, so a computer is best. If you absolutely need to complete the video on a mobile device, you'll be prompted to install the EdPuzzle app. \*The video is 25 minutes, so please watch it when you have time to get all the way through it.
- 2. If you have two or more highschool athletes, you only need to watch the video once. **Please enter all your children's names** at the start of the video. The athletic paperwork does have to be completed once for each athlete.
- 3. You'll be provided a couple of links near the end of the video for the electronic forms and Sportgait test scheduling. It's important to copy/click those links, so that you can complete the electronic forms and schedule your Sportgait test. No worries if you miss the links. We'll be following up with families that complete the video portion each week and providing the links.
- 4. The Sportgait test is required annually, so even if your athlete(s) had one last year, a new one is required.
- 5. For those that are unsure of the physical date we have on file, please feel free to respond to this email and we can provide that information.
- 6. Information you will need before getting started with the paperwork:
  - Last physical date
  - Insurance coverage information (company, member id)
  - Primary medical clinic name and phone number
  - Primary dental clinic name and phone number
  - Preferred hospital name and phone number

Please read the Xavier Athletic Code and the WIAA Eligibility Information Bulletin

<u>Physical Form:</u> A current physical – which is good for two years – is required. Any physical taken on or after **April 1, 2023**, will be good for the 2023-24 and 2024-25 school years. Typically, incoming freshmen and juniors will turn in a physical card.

Alternate Year Card: The alternate year card is required for the second year of the physical. The parent/guardian completes this form digitally. If the on-file physical was dated before April 1, 2022, then the alternate year card is required for the 2023-24 school year. Typically, incoming sophomores and seniors will complete an alternate year card.
